

# Mastering Telephone Conversation

Many of us can speak well when we face others face to face rather than conversing in phone, when we try to speak well in phone the problem persists because of lack of practice conversing in phone. ## Part I:

Method to follow:

- a) Put your mobile in a silent mode.

## Part II

- c) Try with random mobile helplines for example one day hutch, then airtel, spice, tata, reliance, idea, BSNL , see how many service providers so you can talk, talk, talk for FREE

Advantages:

- a) At first stammering comes but don't leave them. Try until you get fluency.
- b) Firstly the person in the other end cannot put the phone down, as you are a valid customer for them.
- d) Secondly they are in the compulsion to answer your question however we fumble.
- e) We are getting a live experience.
